NOTICE OF CHANGE EFFECTIVE SEPTEMBER 1, 2018:

Only FINAL settlement documentation will be accepted as proof of the checkoff withheld. Copies of check stubs, price later, or advance contracts will no longer be accepted.

These funds support the promotional efforts of Iowa corn producers as stated in Chapter 185C of the Iowa Code. In compliance with Iowa law, each bushel of corn marketed in the state of Iowa is checked off. Producers who choose not to support the corn promotional program may use this application to request a corn checkoff refund.

- Proof of checkoff in the form of **final settlement documentation** must accompany the refund application. See below for documentation requirements. *Failure to do so will result in delay or denial.*
